Te Ara Tupua - Reef Enhancement Proposal

As part of the environmental measures for Te Ara Tupua, a new proposal has been developed to establish a reef off the coast between Ngā Ūranga and Pito-One.

The proposal would see a reef built out of concrete structures placed on the sea floor. It is intended to enable improved marine habitat, providing surfaces that ocean plants, and shellfish can grow on, supporting fish and other marine life. This helps to respond to habitat lost as part of building the new coastal defences and shared path.
